



01 ANCON BEACH

Beach of fine white sand and turquoise blue waters. Diving and snorkeling are among its main attractions, with more than 20 diving areas. With the Marlin and Gaviota Marinas you will have diving, fishing, boat rides, in addition to visiting the Blanco and Macho Afuera keys.



02 MANACA IZNAGA

Monumental complex whose exponents are the dwelling house, the bell tower, the warehouse - smithy - kitchen, the slave house and the infirmary. Its distinctive feature, and one of the most emblematic of the Valley, is the tower of 43.5 meters high. It is the only one of its kind in Cuba.



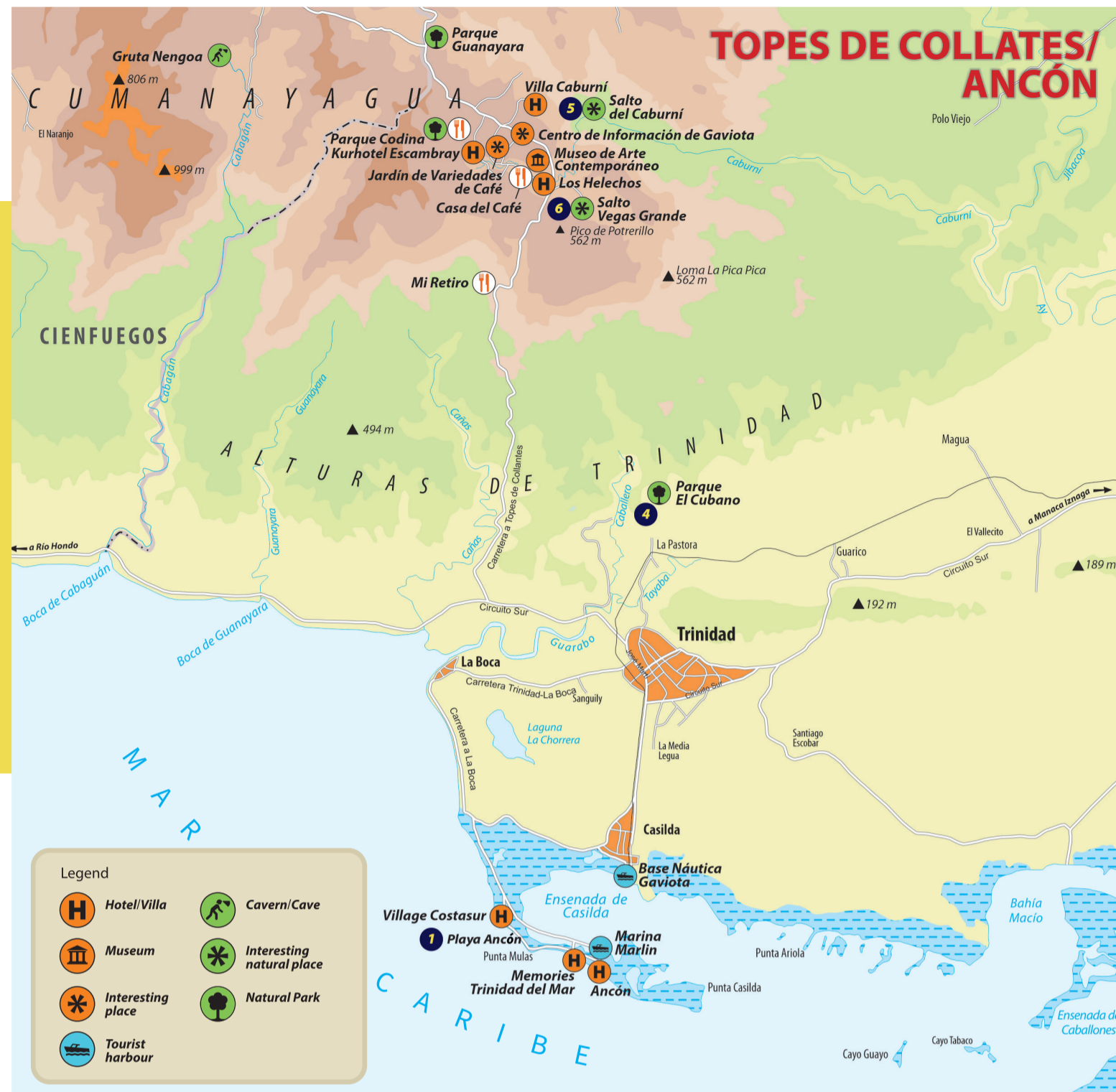
03 SAN ISIDRO DE LOS DESTILADEROS

Catalogued by experts as the most complete traditional architectural complex of the sugar industry of one of the sites that integrate the World Heritage List. The hacienda house, the bell tower and the ruins of the so-called "Jamaican train" are proof of this.



04 EL CUBANO NATURAL PARK

The trail "Huellas de la Historia" (Footprints of History), with a low level of complexity, hanging bridges and a well-designed route will lead you to Salto de Javira. You will have baths in waterfalls and pools, horseback riding, canopy, camping, nautical tours, and bar and restaurant service.



05 CABURNÍ TRAIL

Ideal for lovers of hiking with a high level of complexity. In the Topes de Collantes Natural Park, with a drop of around 64 meters (among the highest in Cuba), it has a system of waterfalls linked to lagoons and pools of crystalline waters.



06 VEGAS GRANDES TRAIL

With an inclination of 45° it is the **second highest waterfall in Cuba**. A cave, a viewpoint, waterfalls, pools for bathing, birds and plants await you. Ideal for lovers of hiking with a high level of complexity and adventure.



07 VALLE DE LOS INGENIOS LOOKOUT POINT

One of the most unique attractions of the destination, where you can admire a unique landscape, ecological and cultural system declared a World Heritage Site in 1988. An adventure in the canopy, with 1200 meters long and 10 platforms for 5 jumps await you.



08 CASA HACIENDA BUENA VISTA

One of the oldest in the Valle de los Ingenios (1747), with a marked neoclassical influence. The privileged position of the property allows you to enjoy the scenic beauty of the valley from different points of the mansion. It provides lodging services and gastronomic offers.

01 THE MAIN SQUARE

The oldest square in Trinidad; the church was built in front of it and it is surrounded by majestic mansions from the XVIII and XIX centuries. It is the central nucleus from which the town developed.



02 NATIONAL MUSEUM FIGHT AGAINST BANDITS

The most important building from the architectural point of view (1730), in its rooms it gathers part of the history of the fight against the counterrevolutionary guerrilla deployed in the hills of the Escambray. From the bell tower you can take a panoramic photo of the city.



03 LA CANCHÁNCHARA

The most popular tavern in the city, where you will taste the typical drink of the city "La Canchánchara", traditional drink in the Liberator Army of the XIX century, based on ice, lemon juice, honey and sugar cane brandy, and you can dance to the rhythm of pure Cuban son.



04 CASA DE LOS MACHADOS «CASA DE LA TROVA»

It treasures pieces of high patrimonial value, and a valuable collection of national and local discography. Diverse cultural activities and dances show the tradition and identity of the city. It is an ideal place to dance to Cuban music and enjoy Cuban cocktails.



05 CARRILLO SQUARE «CÉSPEDES PARK»

Main urban project of the first half of the 19th century, built as the culmination of the settlement of the southern area of the city. Over the years it has become the center of modern life in Trinidad. Its enormous dome or pergola built of iron pieces distinguishes it.



06 MUSEUM OF ARCHITECTURE

The only one of its kind in the country, it shows the development of the vernacular house (1819). In 1980 it was inaugurated as a museum, known as the Blue House. It has eight exhibition rooms where you can discover the local architecture and the works of artists and artisans.



07 MUNICIPAL HISTORY MUSEUM «PALACIO CANTERO»

Recommended to learn about the history of Trinidad since its foundation, about the slave trade, the splendor of the sugar industry and the struggles for independence through documents, works of art and other objects. The lookout tower is among its attractions.



08 HOUSE OF MUSIC OF THE EGREM

It offers live traditional Cuban music, Wi-Fi connection, and a store with national discography. Ideal for contemplating the historic architecture while sipping a refreshing Mojito. Salsa and a more lively son take over the amphitheater, which is open until the wee hours of the morning.



09 BENITO ORTIZ ART GALLERY

A large house that preserves elements from the early years of the 19th century. It has three temporary exhibition rooms where you can enjoy the best of Trinidadian art. In a room on the upper floor there is an exhibition of lingerie, a representative tradition of Trinidad.



10 HANDICRAFT MARKET

Ideal to take a souvenir of our wonderful city, you will find varied samples of popular handicrafts, identifying Trinidad as a Craft City of the World.



11 PALENQUE DE LOS CONGOS REALES

Just a few steps from the Main Square, this cultural center is a source of Afro-Cuban identity and tradition, defended by the Folkloric Ballet of Trinidad. It offers dance and percussion classes by specialists in the field, Trinidadian dancers and percussionists.



12 CASA DEL HABANO

Caracol store specializing in tobacco, rum and coffee, where the product you choose to take with you will be pure Cuban flavor.
